**Ten years ago**, the D28 Committee began refocusing its service energy from being a committee *just for the sake of being a committee* to recognizing that **our district contains a large service need:** 

A great number of men and women suffering and recovering from alcoholism inside the many correctional and other locked-door facilities within our district.

We quickly learned that...

- there were many A.A. men and women volunteers who were already *being of service* to these alcoholics,
- some facilities needed additional volunteers and/or additional meetings,
- some volunteers and/or facilities needed more A.A. literature and supplies.

We began experiencing that being of service to the suffering and recovering alcoholics behind locked doors (as well as being of service to the A.A. members who regularly go inside to meet with them) is a far more meaningful and motivating service experience than operating a bureaucratic committee that produces little more than hot air.

If you're a truly self-motivated and/or higher-power motivated A.A. member who is willing to make a sincere commitment to <u>DO</u> something other than take a committee meeting hostage by listening to yourself blab on and on, then we might be a good fit for you.

We have current volunteer opportunities for:

- **LEADS** in a men's state prison.
- COMMITTED volunteers to regularly attend meetings inside county jails.
- OUTREACH volunteers in juvenile detention & probation, adult probation, drug & DUI courts, treatment centers, schools, and targeted communities like veterans; these efforts require researching and developing contacts with staff at facilities or organizations.
- PICKING UP A.A. literature from Central Office and then delivering it on behalf of a specific meeting at a specific facility.
- **GRAPEVINES!** Old, new, whatever! We'll take all you can get your hands on, because some facilities are hungry for them!
